Johannesburg Zoo

Visitors can enjoy peaceful walks and picnics whilst viewing the 1730 animals in the lush gardens. The Zoo is committed to upholding international standards and the continued welfare of the 365 species.

BRAAMFONTEIN

Is an increasingly popular stop, for interesting Art Galleries, including Wits Art Museum and wonderful food experiences at the Neighbourgoods Market.

44 STANLEY AND NEWTOWN

Is a dynamic cultural quarter, rich in Theatres, Studios and Museums, including Museum Africa, the Workers Museum and the newly opened Frietas Museum. Constitution Hill and Origins Centre are nearby.

THE JOHANNESBURG ART GALLERY.

Is the largest art gallery in Africa, Arts on Main and the Maboneng Precinct are close by. All are free.

A VISIT TO SOWETO, IS A MUST.

Tours are available. Visit the Hector Pieterse Memorial, Vilikazi Street which has produced two Nobel Peace Prize Winners, Mandela House, Credo Mutwa Cultural Village, Kliptown; Eat at Wandies or Jazz Maniacs Restaurant. The spectacularly designed Soweto Theatre is well worth a visit.

OTHER PLACES OF INTEREST TO VISIT WHILST STAYING AT ABIGAILS

Include the Apartheid Museum, Liliesleaf, The Roodepoort Museum, Walter Sisulu Botanical Gardens, The Cradle of Humankind World Heritage Site, also Maropeng and the Sterkfontein Caves. For aviation enthusiasts there is also the Aviation Museum of S.A. China Town in Cyrildene is another treat, with various food specialities from the various Chinese provinces. Sofiatown Heritage Experience has just opened and the Trevor Huddleston Memorial Centre is nearby. The James Hall Museum of Transport is also worth a visit.
